### **St Macartan's Cathedral Restoration – Special Diocesan Collection 15<sup>th</sup>/16<sup>th</sup> November:**

At the request of Bishop Larry Duffy, our parish – along with all others throughout the Diocese of Clogher – will participate in a **special collection next weekend**. The restoration of St. Macartan's Cathedral is a significant undertaking, spread over seven phases. Fundraising for the current phase four is underway, with €1.4m raised in less than 12 months. Some of you have already supported our campaign and for that we are most grateful. Support now is being requested from across all parishes to ensure the Cathedral is preserved. We encourage everyone to make a donation next weekend in our special collection.
